Boy singed on arms, legs with hot spatula by father in Kerala

In a shocking incident, an eight-year-old boy was singed, allegedly by his father with a hot spatula, for not studying, police said.

The incident, which took place on January 30, came to light after a panchayat member informed the police.

The child's father, Srikumkar (31), an alcoholic, has been arrested and remanded to custody, police said.

The boy, who has burn marks on his arms and legs, has been shifted to a child welfare centre at Pathanamthitta, police said.

Man sentenced to 10 years in jail for rape

Banda (UP): A court here has sentenced a man to 10 years imprisonment for raping his teenage cousin in 2016.

Additional District Session Court (POCSO) Judge Pawan Kumar Sharma on Monday also imposed a fine of Rs 50,000 on 26-year-old Lakhanlal.

The girl was raped on August 22, 2016. She was 13 years old then, Public Prosecutor Ramsufal Singh said.

He said a case was registered on August 25, 2016, at Girwan and Lakhanlal was arrested three days later.

The girl's mother in her complaint had said that her daughter was raped several times, Singh said. **PTI**

17 people sexually exploited minor girl for 5 months; aunt among 8 arrested

Bengaluru: Eight people have been sexually exploiting a 15-year-old girl for five months in Chikkamagaluru district, police said.

Among the accused who have been arrested, Sringeri police is her aunt who had been in prostitution, a senior police officer said.

"We have arrested eight people, including the aunt, who had pushed the girl into prostitution. Hunt is on for nine others who were involved in sexually exploiting the girl," the officer said.

According to police, the girl started prostitution after the death of her mother three months ago.

For the past few months she was working in a brick crushing facility and came in contact with several men, who allegedly raped and sexually abused her.

Later, he and his accomplices were arrested and blackmailed her, police said, adding that they were allowed it to happen.

A case has been registered under the Immoral Trafficking Act and Child Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012.

Covid-19 cases cross 8 lakh

Amaravati: The cumulative positive cases of coronavirus in Andhra Pradesh rose to 8,88,004 as 104 were added afresh in 24 hours ending 9 a.m. on Tuesday, even as the active caseload fell below 1,200.

The total recoveries increased to 8,79,651 as 147 more patients got cured.

The overall COVID-19 toll rose to 7,156 with two fresh fatalities, a health department bulletin said.

The state now has 1,197 active cases, it added.
